To assure that all persons coming before the Court are treated equitably. To provide a forum through which persons can have their disputes resolved.

AUTHORITY AND JURISDICTION

The Delaware Municipal Court was created by the Ohio General Assembly in 1952. The Court hears cases from throughout Delaware County, and it has the authority to hear the following kinds of cases:

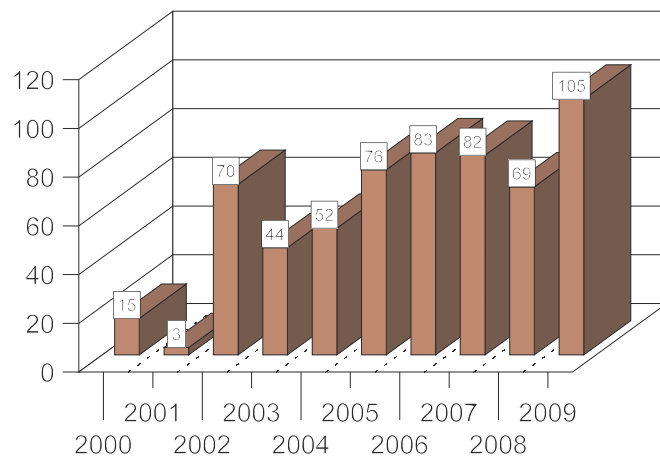
Felony Cases - Initial Appearance/Preliminary Hearings
Misdemeanor Cases - Through Final Determination
Traffic and Parking Violations
Civil Actions - Up to \$15,000.00
Small Claims Actions - Up to \$3,000.00
Administrative Appeals (BMV Cases)

The Judges preside over civil, criminal, and traffic cases and conduct jury and non-jury trials. In jury trials, the judges interpret the law and the jury determines the factual matters. In non-jury trials - by far the more common - the judges have the dual role of interpreting the law and determining the facts. The judges conduct criminal arraignments and preliminary hearings on felony cases; set bond on criminal charges; issue search warrants; and impose sentence when a defendant is found guilty of a traffic or criminal charge. The judges hear civil cases where the amount in controversy is \$15,000.00 or less. The judges perform civil wedding ceremonies.

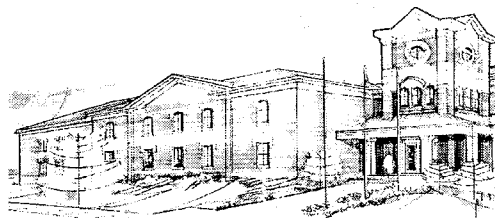

I am proud to present the 2009 Delaware Municipal Clerk of Court Annual Report. This report includes case activity, receipts and disbursements processed by this office. While the case load did not increase, the number of pending cases at the end of the year was reduced by more than 26%. In addition pay-outs were increased more than \$860,000.00 for a total of \$6,013,769.11 in disbursements.

In February of 2009 the Civil Division relocated to the new northwest addition of the Justice Center. They are now able to work together in a designated area allowing for increased operational efficiency. This additional space is greatly appreciated. Also, a Systems Administrator/Deputy Clerk was added to maintain all IT systems operations for both offices. This position manages the court software, audio and video equipment, desktop needs and systems-related staff training.

Beginning March, 2009 the Clerk's office began the process of collecting delinquent fines and costs owed to the court through Capital Recovery Systems, Inc. All costs associated with this process are passed on to the defendant thereby eliminating additional costs to the court. In less than a year, the Clerk's office has recovered more than \$38,000.

In an ongoing effort to strengthen the professional development of my staff, I have continued to utilize the Judicial College courses offered at no cost through the Supreme Court of Ohio. In addition, the Clerk and Court staffs are able to make use of in-house IT training and assistance on an as needed or requested basis. With continued legislative changes expected this cost-effective approach will help our efforts to stay current.

In July of 2009 the first phase of the software upgrade was installed and implemented. The second phase is scheduled for 2010. This upgrade was necessary to comply with The Ohio Supreme Court requirement to participate in the Ohio Court Network program. In addition, the upgrade will include check automation of disbursements for judgments collected through garnishment and bank attachments in the Civil Division and the ability to accept internet payments of waivers and fines due through the Criminal Division.

I would like to thank my staff for their commitment to public service. I pledge to continue to strive to operate this office in the most efficient and effective manner for the citizens of Delaware County.
