All Bidders shall submit a DBE Utilization Plan at the time of bid setting forth specific information demonstrating how the Bidder will achieve the DBE goal. By submitting a DBE Utilization Plan, the Bidder is affirming that they will be using the DBE firms identified in the Utilization Plan to meet the DBE contract goal. **The DBE Goal for this project is 8%.** The DBE Utilization Plan shall be submitted online at <https://odot.formstack.com/forms/dbe>.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the City of Delaware, Ohio, Public Works Facility, 440 E. William St., Delaware, Ohio 43015 at 11:00 a.m., on Tuesday, March 5, 2019.

Prospective bidders may address inquiries to Chad Green through the Bidexpress website. All inquiries must be submitted no later than 4:00 p.m. local time on Tuesday, March 12, 2019.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The City of Delaware reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality and to award the bid or bids to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder as deemed to be in the best interest of the City, as determined by the City Manager.

Bidder's attention is called to all of the requirements contained in this bid packet, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions, Davis-Bacon Wages, various insurance requirements, and various equal employment opportunity provisions.

**ODOT Prequalification Requirement**

*Only pre-qualified contractors are eligible to submit bids for this PROJECT. Pre-qualification status must be in force at the time of bid, at the time of award, and through the life of the construction contract. For work types that ODOT does not pre-qualify, the LPA must still select a qualified contractor. Subcontractors are not subject to the pre-qualification requirement. The "prime" contractor must perform no less than 30 percent of the total original contract price.*
