Income Tax Update – March 18, 2020

The City of Delaware has made several changes to its operations in response to the coronavirus. These steps align with the social distancing recommendations made by the State of Ohio and local health department authorities.

Income Tax Filings 740-203-1225

- The Federal Government announced that the due date for any taxes owed for the 2019 tax year will be extended to July 15. Taxpayers under this extension will still be required to file their returns by April 15 and penalties/interest for any taxes owed will be waived, if paid by the July 15. The City of Delaware also will also extend the payment due date to July 15 and waive penalties/interest while requiring the filing of returns by April 15. There is the possibility that the Federal Government will extend the filing date of returns past April 15 at which point the City will also offer this extension.
- Taxpayers may defer their final 2019 tax payment, as well as first and second quarter 2020 estimated tax payments, until July 15, 2020, without penalty or interest charges.
- Residents can drop off tax payments and paper returns outside City Hall in the red drop box.
- Electronic filing is encouraged for filing a City income tax return. Search “e-file” at www.delawareohio.net for the e-file tool and directions.
