Pursuant to Article XV Sections 73-75 of the Delaware Charter, sealed bids will be received by the City of Delaware, Ohio, City Hall, 1 South Sandusky Street, Delaware, Ohio, 43015 until 11:00 A.M, on Friday, May 10, 2019 through the Bid Express website and opened immediately thereafter, for the following:

The base bid for the 2019 Pavement Maintenance Program (Community Development Block Grant) will consist of the resurfacing of Pumphrey Terrace from Magnolia Drive to S. Sandusky Street, English Terrace from Magnolia Drive to S. Sandusky Street, and Birch Bend from Woodrow Avenue to S. Sandusky Street.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Guaranty meeting the requirements 153.54 to 153.57 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bids shall be submitted through the Bid Express website.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the City of Delaware, Public Works Department at 440 E. William Street, Delaware, Ohio 43015 at 11:00 a.m. local time, on Friday, May 3, 2019.

Prospective bidders may address inquiries to Nathan McCoy, P.E., Project Manager, through the Bid Express web site. All inquiries must be submitted no later than 4:00 p.m. local time on Monday, May 6, 2019.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The City of Delaware reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality and to award the bid or bids to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder as deemed to be in the best interest of the City, as determined by the City Manager.

Bidder's attention is called to all of the requirements contained in this bid packet, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions, Davis-Bacon Wages, various insurance requirements, and various equal employment opportunity provisions.
