




Delaware Police Department


Organizational Chart


Patrol Division

- 2841 WARNING TICKETS

Records Division – Alarm Licensing

- Currently 900 + residences and businesses are licensed in the city. Records processes each license and tracks all false alarms that occur in the city, billing when necessary.



Radio Communications

- Consolidation merged the Police Department and Delaware County 911 on March 30, 2010
 - Consolidation follows a national trend
 - Believed this will provide better coordination between emergency providers in Delaware County.
 - Represents a cost savings by eliminating duplication of services
