Crews Will Collect Soil Samples, Survey Data in Point Area

DELAWARE – The City of Delaware is beginning field tasks for the replacement of the Norfolk Southern railroad bridge located at the intersection of US-36/Ohio-37, also known as The Point intersection. Beginning Monday, March 5 and continuing for about eight weeks, field crews will be working along William Street and Central Avenue, collecting soil samples and land survey data. The work areas are Central Avenue, from Channing Street to Ohio 521, and along William Street, from Foley Street to 521. Traffic will be maintained using flaggers, but intermittent lane closures may occur between 8 am and 3 pm.

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
