DRAINS TO RIVER

- ◆ Rain water washes fertilizers, sediment, oil, and other pollutants into the storm drain. Storm water does not receive treatment before it reaches the Olentangy River. Please help to do your part in protecting our local environment by keeping storm water as clean as possible.
- ◆ Do **NOT** dump, wash, drain, or sweep **ANYTHING** into the storm drains, catch basins, or to the curb! All debris should be collected and disposed of in the trash.
- ◆ Cigarettes are litter too! They are not biodegradable. Cigarette butts are not made of cotton but of cellulose acetate (PLASTIC). Cigarette butts are the *most* littered trash in America.
- ◆ Litter adds debris to the storm drain system which can lead toward clogged pipes and local flooding during heavy or extended rain fall.
