## **Point Project Open House August 21**

**DELAWARE** – The City of Delaware is developing plans to improve traffic flow and safety from the Point intersection to Ohio 521. An initial public involvement meeting was held in May. Information on topics including proposed roadway changes, funding, aesthetics, and the railroad was shared.

The City will host a second open house meeting to share new project information including preliminary construction limits and phasing. The City would like input about the potential social, environmental and economic impacts of the project.
