Dear Resident/Business Owner,

We continue to make progress on converting the U.S. 23-Pennsylvania Avenue interchange from partial-access to full-access operation, and I wanted to take a moment to provide you an update.

Here is where things stand:

- As you may be aware, the management of the project has switched hands to the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT).
- AEP, Frontier, and Time Warner will be on site relocating their lines during February. This is the last piece of the project the City will be directing.
- Full construction of the public improvements by Trucco Construction will occur in the spring, with the goal of substantial completion in time for the Delaware County Fair in 2016.
