 Something needs done about this roadway, it is a major conduit for heavy trucks/semi to gain access to 23 Northbound - these trucks are not going to stop traveling this roadway - and due to their size, the damage isn't going to undo itself. There's always William St as well, which will be impacted it seems for the immediate future for those changes - but progress takes time and some discomfort (such as delays during and for improvements). Not prioritizing and planning for roadway improvements on Central would be the bigger disappointment.

 There really isn't any other option. East Central goes through an older part of Delaware, built before cars were anticipated. I really thank you for providing this forum to express opinions.  The road conditions and traffic are horrible on East Central. I live off this road but try to avoid or drive on it as little as possible due to traffic and condition. Can't wait for it to get fixed properly. Tired of band aid fixes.

 I've lived here on and off for over 10 years and have not been able to figure out why we don't have a Rt36/37 bypass. Giving the truck traffic that isn't stopping in town a way to go around Delaware would go a long way toward solving both traffic and road wear issues.
